Below you will find the breakdown of the 2025 Band Fees. This includes instrumentalists and the auxiliary dance line. Band Boosters will begin taking payments in full or installments beginning March 21st. Please review the Band Handbook for further information.

The season fees can be paid to "NMHS Band Boosters" by cash, check, money order, PayPal (nmhsband4u@gmail.com) or CashApp. Always include the purpose of the payment, student's name and instrument section when making payments. New Instrumentalist Total: \$900

- Instructional techs, supplies, media, repairs, uniform maintenance, additional uniform parts, transportation, special events and competitions- \$600
- Uniform Parts Breakdown (Marching Season and Concert Season)
 - New Members: The totals below are included in your Total Band Fees amount.

Returning Instrumentalist Total: \$600

- Instructional techs, supplies, media, repairs, uniform maintenance, additional uniform parts, transportation, special events and competitions- \$600
 - Returning Members: Must purchase a new T-shirt and will only have to replace lost, damaged, worn, and/or outgrown uniform parts.

Auxiliary Dance Line - \$900 (see note below)

The above fee includes the base cost of uniform parts, hair, make-up, and other performance items. The Auxiliary breakdown will be given by the Line Coach. Auxiliary (Dance Line) will need to follow the payment guideline listed below:

- Instructional techs, supplies, transportation, special events, competitions and media- \$280
- Band Uniform Parts-
 - Band shirt - \$20
- Auxiliary performance items - \$600 (Please note: additional fees may be required based on events scheduled throughout the season. The Line Coach will provide information regarding additional costs.)

Concert Attire- Please note that concert attire is included in the New Instrumentalists fees and does not include dress shoes. Concert attire is considered a full tuxedo (jacket, pants, shirt, bowtie and cummerbund) or concert dress with jewelry set included.

Payment Guidelines:

The payment guideline was generated to ensure the timely ordering of uniforms, supplies, logistical planning and instructional support. Please adhere to the payment schedule to ensure that your student participates in all mandatory performances. Contact the booster treasury or Director of Bands if you have any questions.

Tier 1: Pay prior to the start of band season and receive a 10% discount on initial band dues.

Tier 2: Pay according to the 50/25/25 payment schedule and receive 5% off initial band dues (applied at final payment).

- 50% of band fees are due on, or before, day one of summer band camp.
- 25% of band fees are due on, or before, the first regular season football performance.
- 25% of band fees are due on, or before, the 3rd Friday in September.

Tier 3: Establish a weekly, biweekly or monthly payment plan that meets your financial means. All payment arrangements must be agreed upon at the start of summer band camp.
